IN THE MATTER OF ARPA ACCOUNTS:

County Administrator, Marsha McSherry stated the current fund balance is in the amount of \$42,120.81. There is still a project open for the Kosciusko County Fairgrounds and they have \$6,600.43 for this project to be expended. McSherry stated that would then leave the balance being \$35,520.38, which would be transferred over in the auditor's office to county general for payroll for the Community Coordinator. The rest of the projects are county projects and those will be paid from the current county funds. The rest of the projects include Public Safety Communications, ARPA Admin Expenses, IT-Secure Email, HELP Kosciusko- Chinworth Bridge, CASA Training-Fingerprinting, Fiber WR to Highway, CH Chiller Labor, Fiber COW to WR and Webster Lake Hydro Study.
