

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF
KOSCIUSKO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

WHEREAS: The Kosciusko County Board of Commissioners is responsible for the unincorporated roads in the jurisdiction; *and*

WHEREAS: the residents, employees and employers of said county request to know the conditions of the roadways; *and*

WHEREAS: Kosciusko County experiences excessive snowfalls from time to time.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED: that when the unincorporated roads of Kosciusko County become impassable due to blowing and/or drifting snow, as determined by the Superintendent of the Kosciusko County Highway and concurred to by the Sheriff of Kosciusko County, the Superintendent and/or the Sheriff will contact the Kosciusko County Emergency Management Director who will change the Indiana Department of Homeland Security "County Travel Status Map" to indicate that Kosciusko County is in the Red/Warning level which indicates that "Travel may be restricted to emergency personnel only. Citizens are directed to refrain from all travel, comply with necessary emergency measures, cooperate with public officials and disaster services forces in executing emergency operations plans, and comply with the directions of properly identified officers."

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that when the Red/Warning is announced to the public that the responsibility to choose to use or not to use the unincorporated roads of Kosciusko County falls directly on the residents, employees and employers of Kosciusko County.
